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The Sandwich Project is sponsored by the Minneapolis Recreation Development Non-Profit Organization, and what they do is help the homeless, poor, and disadvantaged families in the Twin Cities every night by providing food, clothing, personal care items, and on-the-street care and support. WE will be helping them by assembling sandwiches for 150 people!

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Many of Love INC's clients experience hardship, disadvantage and barriers that contribute to an overwhelming sense of isolation, fear and loneliness. For our service project we will be making Tie Blankets & Microwavable Heating Packs for LOVE INC.

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From everyday basics like toiletries and paper products to shelf-stable meals and snacks, the items on the Ronald McDonald House Wish List make families' home-away-from-home a more comfortable place to live. What we will be doing for our Sunday Serve project is collecting their most needed items off of their wish list at the Chaska Target and donating them!

February 10th	Camp Rally – MO Minneapolis	*4pm-6:15pm
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As summer approaches and we begin to prepare for Cathedral of the Pines, the high school students put on a Camp Rally that could use our help! We will help with the carnival, serve food, attend the 'camp' service, and help clean up after the meal. And as a way to show our appreciation, volunteers at this event will get T-shirts!
