^{*}Paraments are the cloths hanging off the altar, pulpit, and lectern. Their colors change based on the season of the church year (Easter, Pentecost, Ordinary time, Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, Lent, and some festival days mixed in). Notice that the pastors wear cloths (called stoles), too, that should match the paraments.
