Congregation: Holy God, have mercy on us.

Pastor: For jealousies that divide families and nations, and for rivalries that create strife and warfare.

Congregation: Holy God, have mercy on us.

Pastor: Almighty God in his mercy has given his Son to die for us, and for his sake forgives us all our sins. As a called and ordained minister in the Church of Christ, and by Christ's authority, I therefore declare to you the entire forgiveness of all your sins, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
