

Donor-Advised Fund (DAF)

A donor-advised fund (DAF) is a charitable investment account for the sole purpose of supporting charitable organizations you care about. For many people, it is a way to simplify and consolidate their giving while receiving tax benefits. Anyone can make one-time or multiple gifts to Mount Olivet or its affiliates through a DAF. Gifts from a DAF are called grants.

Helpful Tips on Gifting Using Your DAF

When searching for your charity:

1. **Make sure you have the right Mount Olivet!** There are a lot of organizations with similar names. Our legal name is: **Evangelical Mount Olivet Lutheran Church: Minneapolis, MN**
2. You can also search by our official TAX ID numbers (listed below).

Occasionally, DAF Charitable accounts do not designate who the grant is from. **Please email Tricia Lerohl-Morgan in our finance department: tricial@mtolivet.org and let her know the DAF institution, the amount, and the designation so she can record your gift properly in *Realm*.**

Reminders:

- Since donors have already received a tax deduction via their DAF, grants distributed through your DAF are not eligible for additional tax deductions and will show up in your *Realm* account as non-deductible.
